Introduction

Workshare Compare Server is a web service that performs server-side document comparison and exposes APIs (Application Programming Interfaces) to allow a range of client applications to exploit this functionality. The APIs enable software developers to write custom software that compares two Microsoft Word, RTF, PDF, TXT or HTML documents and produces a redline document that describes the differences between the two documents. Compare Server is installed on a server.

Compare Server exposes simple APIs that allow for integration into a range of client applications and server-based solutions. For example, it can be used by custom solutions that run on your internet site, intranet site, internal network or your email system. Clients can be developed in Java, C#, C++, VB.NET and other languages to integrate Compare Server into your desktop, DMS or document applications.

What's New in Compare Server 9.7

The 9.7 release includes **DVJS 1.6** and has the following new features:

- **Adding first page to redline:** When generating redlines in PDF format that only include pages with changes, (using the **Remove Pages Without Changes** rendering option), the first page is always included in the redline regardless of whether it includes changes.
- Multi-document comparison improvements
- Update to the latest Aspose
- Minor bug fixes

Note: *DVJS (DeltaView JavaScript) is a component of Compare Server that allows comparisons to be viewed and reviewed in the user's web browser. While it is simple to take a comparison document and view it in the browser, DVJS provides richer functionality such as change navigation, change categorization, accept/reject changes and potential for customization by the integrator.*

System Requirements

Workshare Compare Server is designed to run on both entry level and enterprise scale servers. Recommended specifications are given below:

Hardware

| CPU | 64-bit architecture-based computer with Intel or AMD processor with 4 cores |
| Memory | 4GB RAM – More memory may be needed if you intend multiple users to regularly compare long and complex documents. |
| Storage | 1GB free disk space for installation; additional space required for storage of DVJS comparisons and queued comparisons |

Note: Compare Server can be installed on Microsoft Windows 10 for demonstration and evaluation purposes only.

Important Information

Uninstall

To upgrade from previous versions of Workshare Compare Server, you will need to uninstall the previous version. The installer of Compare Server 9.7 will detect earlier versions of Compare Server and stop the installation. It's necessary to manually uninstall previous versions of Compare Server before installing Compare Server 9.7.

You can uninstall previous versions from Add/Remove Programs or by re-running the original installer.

When uninstalling Compare Server, some files, such as log files and configuration files, may not be removed from the machine even after completely uninstalling the product. If you want these files removed, you must do so manually.

Licensing

The license file must be on a local drive of the server machine and not on a mapped network drive or UNC path. It is recommended to copy the LIC file to C:\Program Data\Workshare\Compare Service\bin.

| CS-696 | 500 Error is shown, when comparing specific documents which have all types of table changes. |
| CS-422 | 'outputFormat' parameter content is mentioned in the description of UICompare Swagger documentation. |
| CS-584 | Image changes are not shown in sequential page number order in DVJS Change Summary panel. |
| CS-669 | 429 response code information is incorrectly available in Swagger documentation. |

Known Issues

| DEL-1046 | When comparing M-Files PDFs, some changes may not be highlighted in the redline when they are selected in the Change Summary. |
| CE-23 | When comparing certain tables, the redline may show an entire table section as deleted/inserted rather than just showing the particular changes in the table. |
| CS-634 | It may be possible to accept changes when cells have only been merged. |
| CS-600 | An object is shown in place of the Bitcoin(฿) currency symbol in the DVJS UI. |

| CS-461 | Changes to a footnote reference number are shown in the change summary panel but not shown in the redline. |
| CS-296 | The redline may show overlapping text when showing changes to complex nested textboxes inserted through the 'Text Box' insertion option in Word. |
